RFP SECTION 4.38.2 Performance Bond

A. The successful Offeror shall deliver a Performance Bond, or other suitable security, to the State after notification of recommended award.

B. The successful offeror must submit a performance bond, or other suitable security, in the amount of \$1,000,000 per Functional Area offer/award, guaranteeing that the contractor shall well and truly perform the contract.
