

AMENDMENT #6 – OCTOBER 10, 2024

This Amendment #6 is being issued to amend and clarify certain information contained in the above referenced RFP. All information contained herein is binding on all Offerors who respond to this RFP. Specific parts of the RFP have been amended and are listed below.

Amendment #6

The submission date and time for responses to the LCMCS RFP #2024-01 is hereby amended to **November 25, 2024 at 14:00 local time.**

Further, the below requirement is being added to the RFP. Should Offerors have questions related to this new requirement, the Agency will accept written questions until **October 16, 2024 at 17:00** local time. **Only questions related to this new requirement will be accepted.**

Additional Requirement

2.3.1.5 Retail Training and Demonstration Center

A. General. Offerors shall provide a retail training and demonstration center for use by the Lottery. The space is to be in, or adjacent to, the Offeror's proposed Maryland Operations Center near Baltimore. It is to be configured and built out as a lottery retailer business location. Possible uses include as a location where staff can operate terminals and gain familiarity with equipment, demonstrations for potential retailers or other parties, and as a set for television commercials. Additional lighting for commercial shoots shall be supported, but would be provided by the production company. The center shall be available for Lottery use on 24-hour notice. This center does not supersede the requirements for demonstration and training terminals in our headquarters as identified in question 59.

B. Retail Training and Demonstration Center Requirements. The center shall be configured with the following:

1. Minimum size 350 sq. ft.
2. Retailer furnishings:
 - a) Cash register;
 - b) Sales counter;
 - c) Shelving stocked with inventory; and
 - d) Generic non-lottery POS materials;
3. Lottery equipment:
 - a) One or more of each type of retailer terminal;
 - b) One all game self-service lottery terminal;
 - c) One draw game only self-service lottery terminal;
 - d) Two working monitor game monitors;
 - e) Jackpot sign(s);

- f) Lottery logo sign;
- g) Play station;
- h) Current Lottery POS materials; and
- i) Sample on-counter or in-counter sales equipment, if offered and selected by the MLGCA.

The cost of this Retail Training and Demonstration Center is to be included in the base price. The item described in this new Section 2.3.1.5 is not an individually identified evaluation criteria in Section 6.2.1 Offeror's Technical Response to Requirements and Work Plan. Instead, the requirements for this item are broadly considered as part of an Offeror's overall Proposal quality.

Except as expressly amended herein, all other terms, provisions and conditions in the RFP remain unchanged and in full effect.
